## **BIOGRAPHY:**

Henry Rehder was the son of German-speaking immigrant parents. Henry was born in Woodland Park, Colorado, where his father worked in a quartz mine. The Rehder family came to Pleasant Valley in 1902. Henry and his younger brother Karl trapped and sold pelts to buy their Pleasant Valley ranches—Henry on Harrison Creek and Karl at the foot of Rabbit Ears Pass. Henry raised sheep and cattle. During the depression, Henry, Karl, and Pleasant Valley friend Roman Trentaz went to Manhattan Beach, CA to work. There Henry befriended Albert Einstein, and the two often went for walks along the California beach. Henry's first wife, Thelma Larson, bore him a daughter, Bonnie, before Thelma died of Parkinson's disease. Henry later married Helen Rosalie, and the two traveled the world together. Helen Rehder was an accomplished painter and enjoyed collecting Indian artifacts. Henry liked hunting, fishing and traveling. They lived on the Harrison Creek Ranch.
