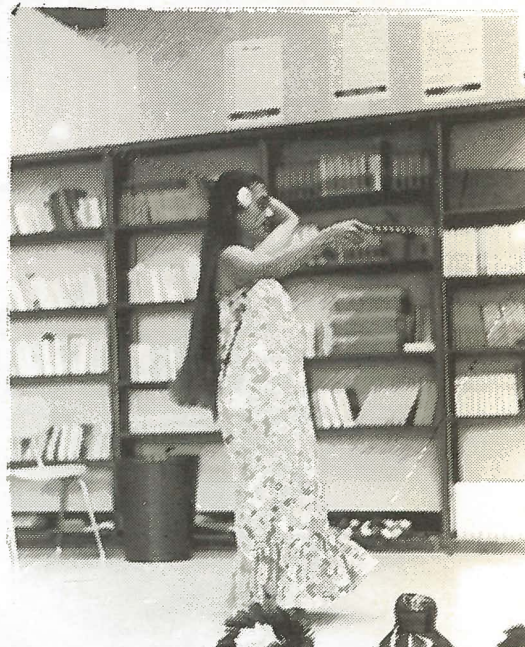


MICHELLE SHOWING HER GRASS SKIRT.
